

Istropolis

"Istros" is the ancient Greek name of the Danube river, which together with the word "polis" base the name Istropolis = "Danube City". The capital city bore this name in the reign of the King Mathias Corvinus (15th century), who was the King of Hungary and the King of Bohemia. During this era Bratislava thrived evidenced by the first university in this region Academia Istropolitana.

Pressburg

Bratislava in 19th century had very diverse structure of the citizens. At that time, Bratislava was German-Slovak-Hungarian city and each ethnic had its name of the city. Pressburg was the official German name of Bratislava used until 1918, when the first republic of Czecho-Slovakia was created and the new and only name of the city (Bratislava) has been established.

Bratislava

The name Bratislava has its roots in times, when the King of the Great Moravian Empire Svätopluk reigned (864 A.D.). While he was seating at the Castle Devin, his third-born son, the Great Moravian prince Braslav, was dwelling at the castle on a ridge above the Danube - Braslavgrad. There are many ethymologic variations of the name until 1919 (the Treaty of Versailles), when one thousand years of the Kingdom of Hungary ended, and the first republic of Czecho-Slovakia was created. Since then, the city has official name Bratislava.

Bassan

The end of the glorious era of the Great Moravian Empire was caused by armies of migration of Hungarians coming from Asia. Inhabitants of the Bratislava castle lived and worked under the occupation for one thousand years. In 11th century, the castle was a possesion of a Slovak prince Božan. The name "Bassan" appeared in dossiers from the 12th century, where Arabic geographer Idris mentioned the name of the city perharps as the variation of the prince's name Božan.

Pozsony

Pozsony is the Hungarian name of Bratislava. Its history roots to the times when the city was occupied by armies of migration of Hungarians coming from Asia (10th century). The Slavic language as the official language was withdrawned, instead Latin and Hungarian established. At this time, the Bratislava castle was a possesion of a Slovak prince Božan out of whom the new — Latin (Posonium) and Hungarian (Possony) names were derived.
