- LANGUAGE COURSE: French language and culture classes are organised for both semesters
- LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT: For the programmes taught in English, we strongly recommend that non-native English speakers or students not taking their home university degree in English provide a TOEFL score of 550 or equivalent or have an English professor complete the English language certificate, attesting to a minimum of B2 according to the Common European Framework.
- For the programmes taught in French, we strongly recommend a B2 French level.
